



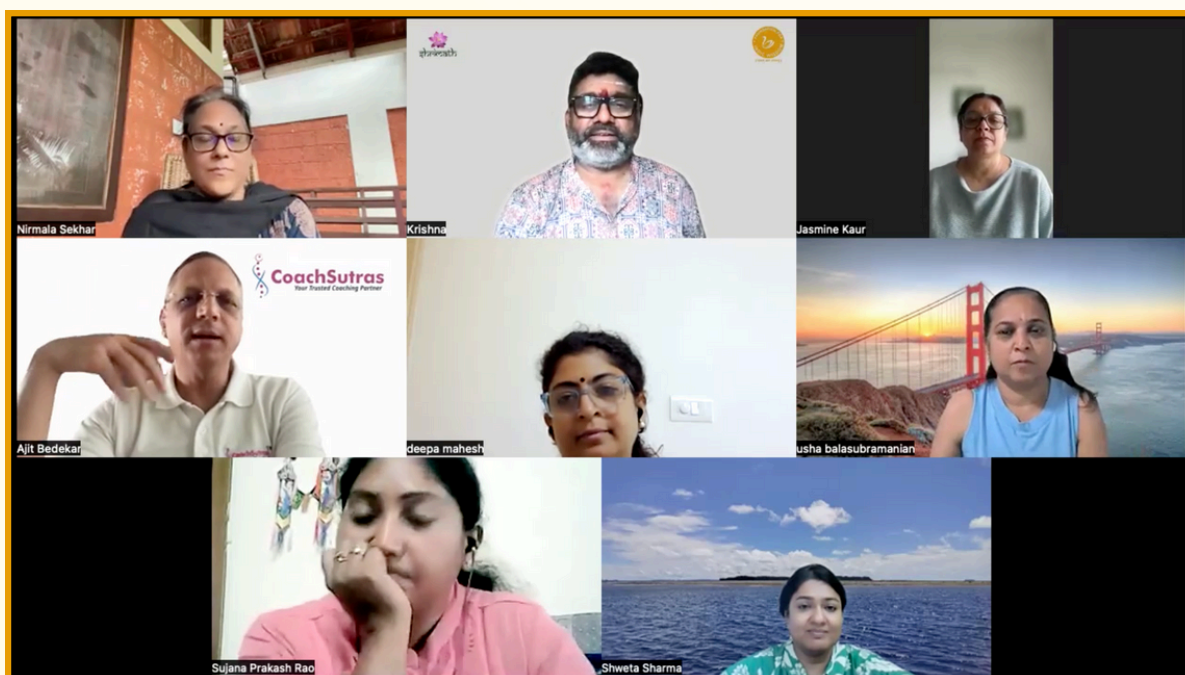

Krishna Prakash – Journey in Indic Wisdom

Krishna's journey into Indic Wisdom began in 1997 under Master Sri (IIT-Madras alumnus, 1975–80) at Sringeri Mutt's management institute, where he learned to integrate business with Indian Shastras.

From 2000, he immersed himself in Master Sri's teachings on the Bhagavad Gita, Yoga Sutras, Lalitha Sahasranama, and select Upanishads, later serving as official scribe (2004–2009) for workshops on Enlightened Leadership, Enlightened Women, and Spiritual Awakening.

A dharma-sankata over a million-rupee billing decision in 2004 led him to close his HR placement venture, choosing Dharma over profit. This turning point, along with leadership roles at BNI, seeded his programs on Leadership, Life, and Living rooted in Indic Wisdom.

Between 2004 and 2010, Krishna worked with world-class sportspersons, musicians, and corporate leaders at Shreyas Retreat, shaping his Indic Wisdom-based coaching system. A transformative stay at the Bihar School of Yoga in 2009, where he received blessings from Swami Satyananda, gave rise to Shrimath Yoga Nidra.

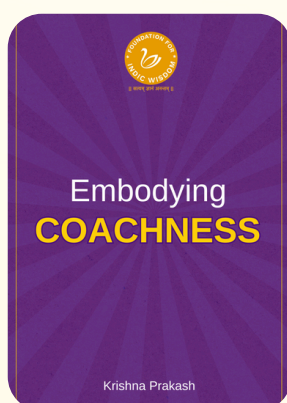
Leaving corporate life at 35, Krishna has since trusted the Divine and served as an instrument for seekers in 48 countries.

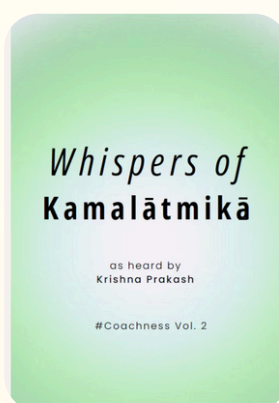

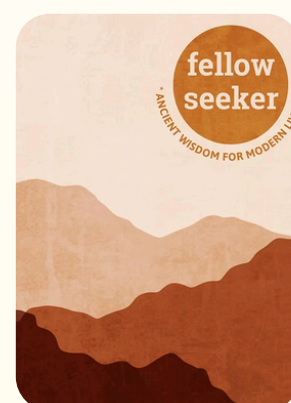
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
